- Workshops cover the basics of applying, and consultations offer in-depth advice

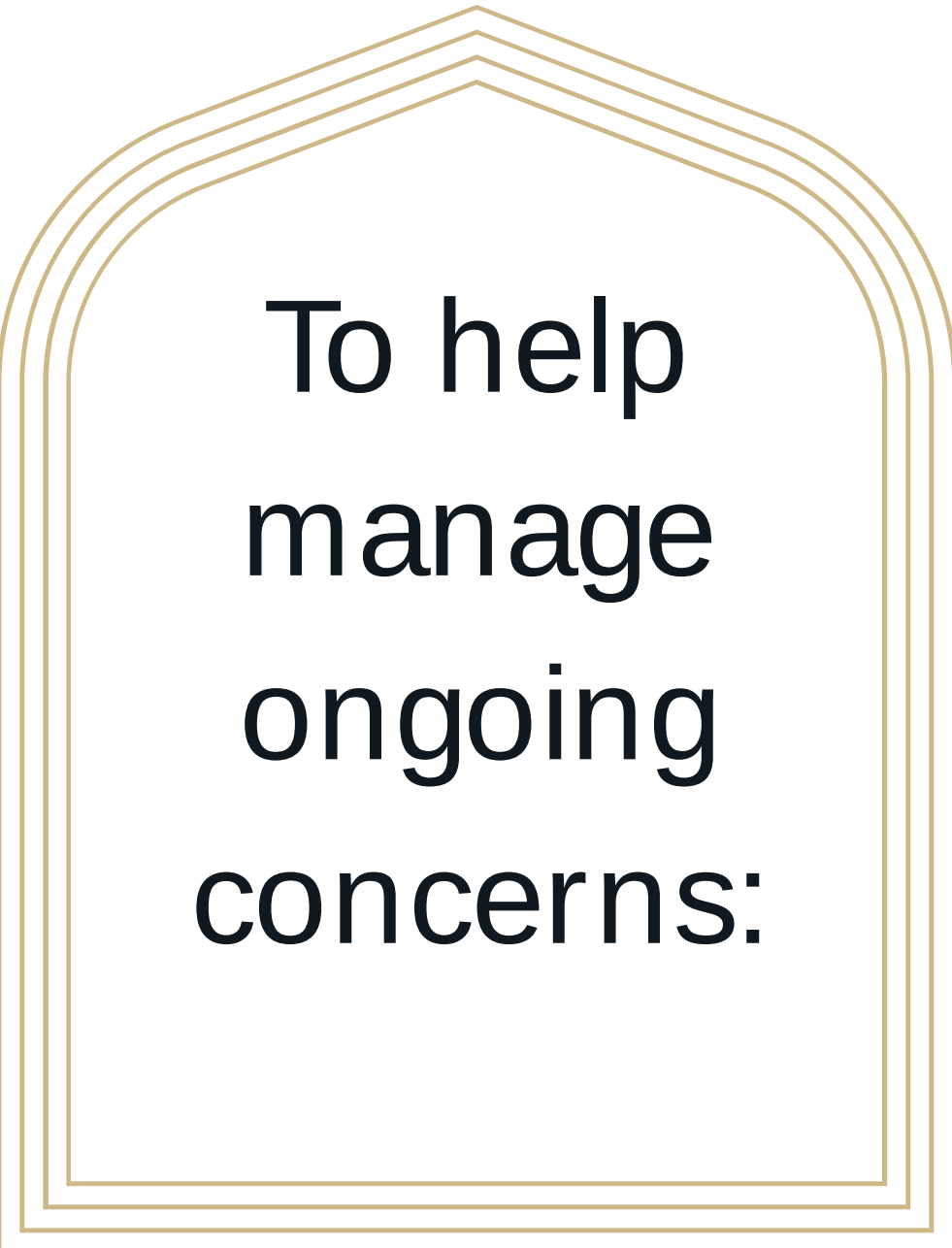




Center for Intensive English Studies (CIES)
